

Getting to Environmental Change Institute and Oxford University Centre for the Environment

The **Dyson Perrins Building** is a large red brick building about half way down South Parks Road in either direction, nearly opposite where Mansfield road joins South Parks Road. The main entrance and reception is behind the building - turn through some black railings on the eastern side of the building, into a car and bike parking area. You will see the entrance to OUCE on the left up a couple of steps.
