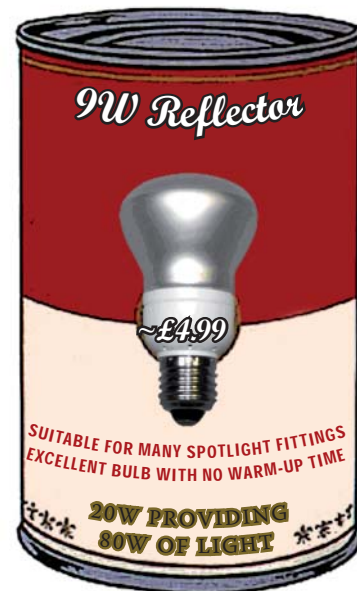
## Choose your wattage:

How bright do you want your light to be? Our library shows bulbs from 5w (equivalent to 20w incandescent) to 25w (equivalent to 100w incandescent)



## Choose your style:

Multicoloured, dimmable, spotlights, LEDs, soft glow, daylight, UV... these are just some of the light bulbs available – something for nearly every occasion.



## Choose your fittings:

Most bulbs are available in bayonet, screw fix, in small and standard sizes



## Light Jargon

CFLs – compact fluorescent lights

Incandescent – the 'traditional' lightbulb... soon to become collectors items!

LEDs – light emitting diode

Carbon footprint - a measure of the amount of carbon dioxide or CO2 emitted through the combustion of fossil fuels – which produce our electricity. The more energy we consume, the larger our carbon footprint. Using less energy in low-energy lights reduces our carbon footprint. Easy.

Watts / wattage - a unit/units of power

Bayonet – fixing that twists and locks into the fitting (see 30W Full Spiral above)

Screw – fixing that screws into the fitting (see 15W Traditional above)
