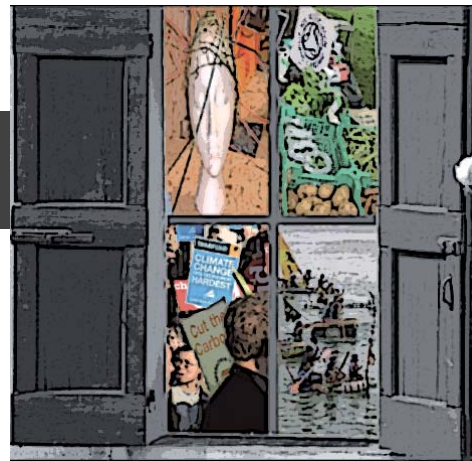
Cost: £2 per entry (which covers the cost of the climate info pack).
